Disposable does not always mean flushable.

Household cleaning and baby wipes do not dissolve, they get stuck in sewer pipes and equipment.

Be kind to your plumbing...

The toilet is not a trash can, please throw used wipes in the garbage.

Better option:
Clean with reusable cloths.

Costs for hiring a plumber to unclog your private sewer line typically ranges from \$75.00 to \$350.00.

These costs do not include the time it takes cleaning up the sewage that may have backed up into your home or business, or the time spent calling and waiting for a plumber.

In addition, dental floss, kitchen waste, kitty litter, plastic or latex items, and needles can all clog pipes and should be bagged or contained and placed in the trash.
