Adopt an ordinance introduced by Council Member Henson at a meeting of the Hayward City Council on June 16, 1998.





PUBLIC NOTICE OF AN INTRODUCTION OF AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAYWARD

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 4, CHAPTER 11
OF THE HAYWARD MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING
SECTION 11-4.24 THERETO RELATING TO
UNDERGROUND DISTRICT NO. 24

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAYWARD DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Article 4, Chapter 11 of the Hayward Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding thereto Section 11-4.24, to read in full as follows:

"SEC. 11-4.24 UNDERGROUND DISTRICT NO. 24. The following described area in the City of Hayward is hereby designated as an underground district, to wit:

Mission Boulevard from Overhill Drive to 700 feet southerly of Arrowhead Way, and Industrial Parkway from Dixon Street to Mission Boulevard.

The following exceptions apply to this District:

- (a) Any municipal facilities or equipment installed under the supervision and to the satisfaction of the City Engineer.
- (b) Overhead wires (exclusive of supporting structures) crossing any portion of a District within which overhead wires have been prohibited, or connecting to buildings on the perimeter of a District, when such wires originate in an area from which poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures are not prohibited.
- (c) Antennae, associated equipment and supporting structures, used by a utility for furnishing communication service.
- (d) Equipment appurtenant to underground facilities, such as surface mounted transformers, pedestal mounted terminal boxes and meter cabinets, and concealed ducts.
- (e) Temporary poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures used or to be used in conjunction with construction projects.

The underground system hereby approved and the connection to be made to the system shall be completed by February 1, 2000. The removal of all poles and overhead wires shall be

completed by June 1, 2000. These dates may be postponed by the City upon notification to the affected property owners.

Section 2. In accordance with the provisions of Section 620 of the City Charter, this ordinance shall become effective 30 days from and after the date of its adoption.

Introduced at a regular meeting of the Hayward City Council held June 16, 1998, the above entitled ordinance was introduced by Council Member Henson.

This ordinance will be considered for adoption at the next meeting of the Hayward City Council, to be held on June 23, 1998, at 8:00 p.m., in the Council Chambers, 777 B Street, Hayward, California.
