SUBJECT: Pavement Reconstruction FY11 – Bahama Avenue: Approval of Plans and Specifications and Call for Bids

RECOMMENDATION

That Council adopts the attached resolution approving the plans and specifications for the Pavement Reconstruction FY11 – Bahama Avenue Project and calls for bids to be received on June 15, 2010.

BACKGROUND

This project represents the seventh year of the City's pavement reconstruction program. This year's project is for pavement reconstruction on Bahama Avenue from Sleepy Hollow Avenue to West Tennyson Road (see Attachment II). The proposed improvements will repair the pavement section of Bahama Avenue and improve the riding surface and the appearance of the street.

DISCUSSION

The maintenance program involves reconstruction of severely deteriorated streets to return them to acceptable pavement condition standards. Bahama Avenue was selected for reconstruction using the City's computerized Pavement Management Program and visual field-examination by staff. Because of the severity of the pavement deterioration, typical dig-out spot repair and pavement overlay for this street would not be cost effective. The work consists of removing the existing pavement to the subgrade, compacting and installing full-depth asphalt concrete, adjusting utility structures to the new grade, and installing pavement markings and stripings.

The project is categorically exempt under section 15301(c) of the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines for the operation, repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing facilities.

FISCAL IMPACT

The estimated project costs are as follows:

Contract Construction	\$384,000
Design and Administration	58,000
Construction Survey, Inspection, and Testing	<u>58,000</u>
Total	\$500,000

The FY 2010 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) includes \$500,000 for this project in the Street System Improvements Fund.

PUBLIC CONTACT

Because of the temporary inconvenience caused by the pavement reconstruction work, immediately following contract award, a preliminary notice explaining the project will be distributed to all residents and businesses along Bahama Avenue and the surrounding streets. After the construction work has been scheduled, signs on barricades will be posted indicating the date and time of work. During the construction, the contractor will place ramps to provide access to all driveways.




