Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)

- Program of U.S. Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Dept.
- Established in 1974
- Provides annual formula grants to 1200 general units of local government and States
- Helps local governments serve low- and moderate-income persons and revitalize communities through:
 - ✓ *Affordable Housing & Housing Rehabilitation*
 - ✓ *Neighborhood Facilities & Improvements*
 - ✓ *Public Services*
 - ✓ *Economic Development / Commercial Rehabilitation*

Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)

- Total FY 2011 CDBG program funding (U.S.): \$3.984 billion
- Projected CDBG funding decrease in FY 2012 (U.S.): 16%
 - ✓ *Seventh Federal FY 2011 Continuing Resolution, executed on April 9, 2011 = 16% cut to CDBG program*
- Hayward is an “Entitlement” grantee
 - ✓ *Funding is provided annually upon HUD’s approval of City Council’s CDBG allocations*
- Citizen Participation: Citizen’s Advisory Commission, NOFA, etc.

CDBG funding available for eligible activities in Hayward

- ✓ *FY 2011: \$1,620,830*
- ✓ *FY 2012 (estimated): \$1,593,830*

Council's CDBG Categories of Need

- ✓ *Affordable Housing & Housing Rehabilitation*
- ✓ *Neighborhood Facilities & Improvements*
- ✓ *Public Services**
- ✓ *Economic Development / Commercial Rehabilitation*

** 15% may be used for Public Services, per CDBG regulations and Council policy. Council policy is to use Public Services funding to support exclusively housing-related social services for low-income Hayward residents.*





Other Funding: Social Services Program Grants

- General Fund grants to private nonprofit and public social services agencies that serve lower income Hayward residents
- Supports other types of community services that are outside the parameters of CDBG
- Subject to City of Hayward Contracting and Reporting Standards
- Two-year funding recommendation cycle (FY 2012= Year 2)
- Recommendations brought forward to Council with City's FY 2012 Budget
- Citizen Participation: Human Services Commission, NOFA, etc.
