Definition of Full Service Restaurants

- minimum 60 percent of gross receipts from non-alcohol sales;
- meals available to guests at all times the restaurant is open;
- not a full-service restaurant if alcohol is served without meal service being provided;
- any bar/lounge area cannot remain open when the dining area is closed;
- abides by standards related to minimizing impacts on public health and safety, etc.



Definition of Full Service Restaurants, cont...

- “a full service restaurant shall not offer or permit any form of live or recorded entertainment; including by way of example and not limited to, the playing of recorded music by a disc jockey, karaoke, dancing, video or mechanical games. Background music complementary to a dining experience may be provided as determined by the Chief of Police”;
- “a full service restaurant shall not offer any type of reduced price promotion for alcoholic beverages served on the premises”




Full Service Restaurants - Proposed Temporary Revisions

- Reduced price alcohol sales from 4:00 to 9:00 pm, along with reduced prices for appetizer food items and non-alcoholic drinks;
- Live or recorded music is allowed until 10:00 pm; no dancing is allowed; and music does not violate the City's Noise Ordinance

No vested right conferred to continue after the Trial Program ends and City Council can end Trial Program at any time.
