


Route 238 Corridor Improvement Project


- Hayward's largest Public Works Project

Map of Existing Parking – Foothill (City Center to Grove)




Additional On-Street Parking

- Requested by Downtown Merchants
- Traffic Demand has reduced, possibly due to:
 - Current Route 238 project construction activities;
 - Current economic climate
 - Completion of Caltrans work on I-580, I-238; and 880/92 interchange
- Additional on-street parking is not a viable long-term strategy




