Presentation to Mayor Sweeney and Members of the Hayward City Council
Public Comment period prior to Executive Session 5PM.

1. Mayor Sweeney and the Engineering staff have been responsive and taken action to assist the senior and disabled public transit residents of Hayward Village Senior Apartments located at 22078 Arbor Avenue with specific reference to the pedestrian walkway on West A Street and Happy land.

Mr. Frascinella and the City Manager have communicated with me in letters. Mr. Frascinella told me in January of this year that the City received funding for the final enhancement to the pedestrian walkway. This will require the car drivers to STOP using A street as the Indy 500 raceway. He told me the final change should be completed sometime this year.

2. AC Transit removed the bus embarkation stop at Arbor Ave and A Street. Correspondence relating to the deleterious impact of this change to the senior and disabled residents is profound. I hand delivered letters to the GM of AC Transit, Mayor Sweeney's Office and the Hayward Engineering office.

Correspondence to me from AC Transit and Mr. Frascinella and my subsequent meeting with him 1/13 (posted in various places in the residence) stated a new bus stop would be established between and Arbor and Hathaway Streets. Changes have begun.

We are asking that the City staff put the change on the fast track so that we can have the new bus stop as soon as possible.
