

The City of Hayward's Pretreatment Program

- Required by federal and state regulations since we treat our own wastewater.
- Regulates industries discharging to the City's sanitary sewer.
- Includes inspections, permits, sampling, and reporting.



The Program's Purpose...

- Protect the WPCF and collection system from substances deleterious to the Plant's operations; and,
- Abide by all the Federal and State requirements to regulate sanitary discharges to protect water quality (S.F. Bay).



Regulator Obligations for the City's Pretreatment Program

- Comply with a wastewater permit requirements from the Clean Water Act
- Comply with federal regulations for permitting and managing dischargers
- Institute and implement the City's municipal wastewater discharge ordinance
- Receive and respond to Water Board Audits



Amendment to the City's Wastewater Discharge Regulation Ordinance

- Update to respond to the recent 2012 pretreatment audit
- Update to include the Pretreatment Streamlining Rule



January 2012 Pretreatment Audit

- Assessed compliance with regulations
- Findings require modifications to the City's wastewater discharge regulations:
- Clarify compliance requirements and include enforcement actions
- Include definitions and specify enforcement schedules



Pretreatment Streamlining Rule

- Created by the EPA to reduce regulatory burden
- Simplifies pretreatment permits
- Reduces sampling requirements
