



Cannery Café, at 23380 Foothill Boulevard, specializes in providing local, high quality, affordable dishes for breakfast, brunch, and lunch. The café is associated with the Hayward Area Historical Society and Blue Heron Catering.

Cannery Café became Hayward's first restaurant to be certified as a Green Business earlier this year. As a Green Business, the café has implemented separate collection of recyclables and organics, has put into place several water conservation and energy efficiency measures, and uses recycled content paper products.

Way To Be Designs, 30987 San Clemente Street, creates custom and branded merchandise and uniforms for medium and large scale businesses, including McDonalds, Autodesk and Virgin America.

The company became a certified Green Business in 2014, and received the Cool California Climate Leader Award in 2015. Way To Be integrates sustainability into their core values, creating merchandise such as upcycled bags made from recycled company banners and materials.

Sugar Bowl Bakery

Sugar Bowl Bakery, at 1963 Sabre Street, is a family-owned, internationally recognized bakery specializing in madeleines, petite palmiers, and petite brownie bites.

The bakery recently installed a 0.5 megawatt solar array, which provides roughly 65% of the energy needs of the building. Employees have access to 4 electric vehicle charging stations, and a dedicated team regularly inspects the waste stream to ensure employees are continually trained in waste diversion.

A recent best practices review increased efficiency such that the bakery saves approximately \$400,000 per year and has reduced food waste drastically.

Sun Gallery

Sun Gallery, 1015 E Street, is a community-focused, contemporary gallery displaying a variety of art created by professional and emerging artists.

In 2014, the gallery hosted an interactive climate change art show to engage the community in environmentally-related activities and experiences. This week, the gallery will open a California Drought exhibit to showcase art pieces created by students and local artists in an effort to increase awareness about the drought.

The gallery will also be hosting a local launch of 350.org, an international environmental outreach organization, this week.

CSU East Bay was founded in 1957 and has a student body of over 14,000.

The University has installed 1 megawatt of solar, is in the process of constructing their second LEED certified building, and promotes water conservation through landscape management and student education.

CSU East Bay signed the American Colleges and Universities President's Climate Commitment in January 2015 to reach climate neutrality through development of a climate action plan and greenhouse gas inventory.


