It is recommended that the City Council review and comment on the presentation.


BACKGROUND:

The presentation will update the City Council on the operations and programs of the Hayward Fire Department.

The mission of the Hayward Fire Department is to prevent or minimize the loss of life and property due to natural and man-made emergencies and disasters, and to provide essential non-emergency services.

The Operations Division operates out of nine fire stations, including the Fairview Fire Protection District's station, and responds to fires, medical emergencies of all types, automobile accidents and other situations where life or property are endangered. The Fire Prevention Office handles new development, inspects existing occupancies, enforces hazardous materials regulations, and provides disaster preparedness and fire safety education. The Department also participates in local and state-wide mutual aid programs to assist other jurisdictions in coping with large incidents.
