# Solar Receptacles Update

- Receptacles store trash and recyclables, typically in high-pedestrian traffic areas
- Units help reduce litter and reinforce recycling habits
- Three units were purchased and installed in December 2012 using unspent grant funds from the U.S. Department of Energy
- Serviced at no additional cost by WMAC
- Separate water-tight side panels will be ordered to insert posters promoting events or environmental messages


