# Potential New & Enhanced Waste Services

- ▶ Summarize potential new services and enhancements
- ▶ Obtain Committee members' desired changes to current and new services
- ▶ Describe outreach plans to solicit comments
- ▶ Status Report to City Council in July



# Potential New & Enhanced Waste Services

## Contract Negotiations with Franchisee

- Exclusive negotiations to continue through July 11
- Currently preparing a Request for Proposals
- Issue a Request for Proposals in July, if contract discussions with Waste Management do not yield an agreement



# Potential New & Enhanced Waste Services

## Single- & Multi-Family Services

- Second annual appointment to remove bulky items for single-family residents
- Removal of bulky items for multi-family properties
- Removal of abandoned debris placed in the public right-of-way
- Separate collection of organics from multi-family properties
- Choice of carts or a bin for recycling services for multi-family properties



# Potential New & Enhanced Waste Services

## Other Potential New Services

- **Alternative fuel collection vehicles for residential and commercial services**
- **Purchase and installation of new trash and recycling containers in the Downtown**
- **Web-based customer access**
- **Offer compost at annual community event**



# Potential New & Enhanced Waste Services

## Economic Impact

- **New services and enhancements may result in higher rates**
- **Financial incentives support recycling by businesses and multi-family properties**

## Fiscal Impact

- **Franchise fees will not be less than specified in the current agreement**
- **Measure D funds will continue as the City pursues a new contract**



# Potential New & Enhanced Waste Services

## Public Contact

- Presentations scheduled through May 2014 with a variety of community groups to solicit comments
- Distribute surveys for single-family residents, multi-family residents, multi-family property managers and business owners
- Surveys can also be completed by visiting the City's home page and selecting the link 'Waste Management Survey'

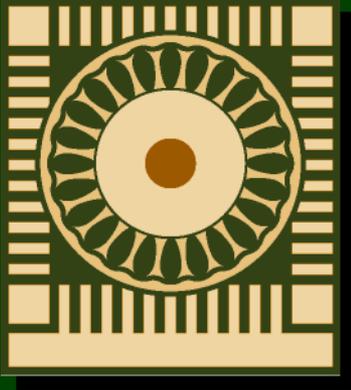


# Potential New & Enhanced Waste Services
