
Community Choice Aggregation

- June 2014 - County Board of Supervisors voted to study the feasibility of establishing a county-wide CCA
- CCA enables local governments to aggregate electricity demand within their jurisdictions
- PG&E would continue to provide billing, transmission, & distribution services



Community Choice Aggregation

- County formed a steering committee to help guide the preparation of feasibility study
- Steering committee will have 39 members including one (1) representative from each city



Alameda County's Schedule

Phase 1

June 2015	Issue RFP for technical study
November 2015	Steering Committee reviews technical study
December 2015	Present study to Board of Supervisors
December 2015	Decide whether or not to proceed with Phase 2

Phase 2

Spring 2016	Form Joint Powers Authority
Summer/Fall 2016	Submit Implementation Plan to CPUC

Phase 3

2017	Secure Energy Contracts
2017	Customer Notifications
By mid-2017	Commence Service
