NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Hayward on Tuesday, October 21, 2014 at the hour of seven (7) o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as the same may be heard, at the location noted above, will conduct a public hearing regarding the following item:

**SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FISCAL
YEAR 2014-15 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN.**

A public hearing is being held for the purpose of a Substantial Amendment to the City of Hayward's CDBG FY 2014-15 Annual Action Plan. This Substantial Amendment would reauthorize reconciled funds from 1976-2014 for the implementation of the Promise Neighborhood Street Improvement Project. This project was identified as having the greatest potential to meet CDBG eligibility requirements, U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development national objectives and timeliness spending deadlines, and City Council Priorities, while fulfilling a critical need in the Hayward community.

The City of Hayward seeks public input regarding this Substantial Amendment.

All interested persons are invited to attend the meeting to speak or offer written comments regarding the Substantial Amendment to the Fiscal Year FY 2014-15 One-Year Action Plan.
